Under Florida Statute Chapter 267, The Florida Historical Commission with consultation from the Secretary of State rank eligible grant applications for funding. These preservation projects are evaluated for historic significance, appropriateness of the technical and financial resources, educational potential, economic benefits and public good resulting from the project.
