The following historic sites are facing development pressure, neglect, maintenance issues, and/or are facing future threats to their preservation. We strongly urge you to continue to help protect these sites and join the local efforts to ensure their preservation.

St. Nicholas III Sponge Diving Boat, Tarpon Springs

Threat: In need of immediate repairs

Cape San Blas Lighthouse, Keeper's Quarters Cottages, and Fuel Storage Building, Gulf County

Threat: Structures must be permanently relocated due to erosion issues

Fire Station #5, Jacksonville

Threat: Potential for demolition due to redevelopment pressure

William J. Howey House, Lake County

Threat: Foreclosure pressure due to mortgage scam on the homeowner

Bonnet House, Ft. Lauderdale

Threat: Pressures from surrounding development

Fort Zackary Taylor, Key West

Threat: Deterioration due to the elements and lack of funding

Miami Herald Building, Miami

Threat: Potential for demolition due to redevelopment pressure

Spanish Courts, Riviera Beach

Threat: Concerns over development pressure

Old Pahokee High School, Pahokee

Threat: Extreme economic concerns

Boynton Beach High School/Mangrove Park School, Boynton Beach

Threat: Incompatible architectural design proposal may diminish historic character
