### **St. Nicholas III Sponge Boat, Tarpon Springs**

Threat: Immediate repairs needed

### **Old Fire Station #5, Jacksonville**

Threat: Potential for demolition due to redevelopment pressure

### **William J. Howey House, Lake County**

Threat: Foreclosure pressure due to mortgage scam on the homeowner

### **Fort Zackary Taylor, Key West**

Threat: Deterioration due to the elements and lack of funding

### **Spanish Courts, Riviera Beach**

Threat: Concerns over development pressure

### **Old Pahokee High School, Pahokee**

Threat: Extreme economic concerns

### **Lewis Spring House, Tallahassee**

Threat: Development pressure, estate settlement, and deferred maintenance
